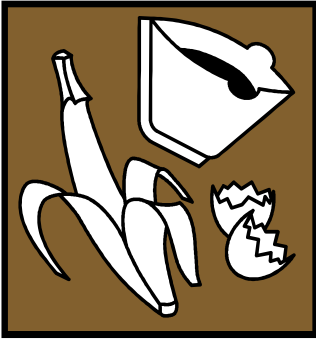


Waste is separated in Germany

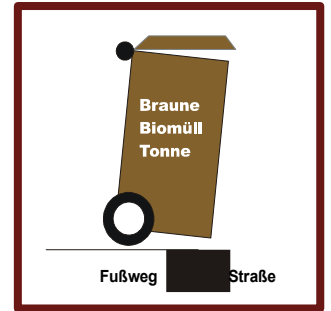


Compost

Fruit and vegetable scraps, coffee filters, small amounts of cooked food waste, leaves, tree branch-, shrub- and grass clippings

STOP

No plastic bags, raw meat and raw bones, feaces

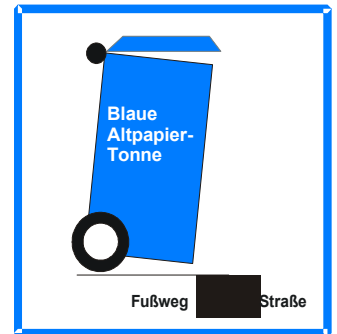


Cardboard, paper

Cardboard, newspapers, magazines, folding cartons exclusively made of paper / cardboard

STOP

No composite packaging such as Beverage cartons, no leftover wallpaper

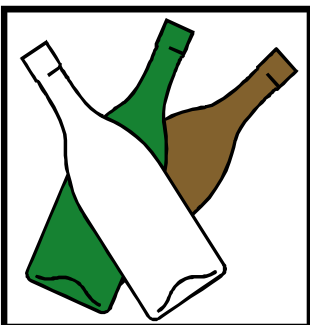


Packaging

Plastic (bottles, films, cups), beverage cartons (milk, juice), foamed plastic containers, cans, empty aerosol cans, sealing cap

STOP

No building materials, styrofoam, no plastic toys, buckets

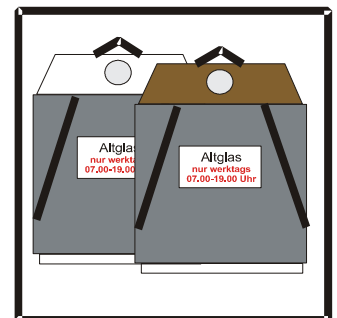


Glass

Disposable bottles, screw top

STOP

No window glass, safety glass, mirrors, ceramic, earthenware, porcelain, bulbs



residual waste

Ash, cigarette butts, toilet paper, diapers, wallpaper scraps, soiled packaging, broken glass, stoneware, porcelain, renovation waste, vacuum cleaner bags, street cleaning waste, dispersion paints, hardened paints and varnishes, small animal and cat litter, raw meat and raw bones and excrement
